

Public Notice

ELECTRICITY ACT 1985 [REGULATIONS 3 [3]]



PURSUANT TO COMMERCE COMMISSION ACT 1998 CAP 50 AND THE ELECTRICITY ACT 1985 CAP 180, Public Notice is hereby given by the Fiji Electricity Authority that the Commerce Commission has authorised tariff increases. The Fiji Electricity Authority shall implement the new tariff to be effective from 06 August 2008.
