1. SECTION 1 SCOPE OF WORK AND SPECIFICATION

THE CONTRACTOR TO PROVIDE

- 1. A lump sum figure with all the breakdown schedule of payments.
- 2. FEA will not make any advance payment.
- 3. FEA will pay as per payment of schedule
- 4. All payment will be made after invoice within 30 days
- 5. Insurance covers
- 6. Procedure to carry out oil leak repairs and application of the product if price is acceptable to fea after award letter.

FEA REQUIREMENT

- 1. The working time shall be 0830 4pm daily working days only, No after hours work.
- 2. Retention 10% for 26 weeks
- 3. Duration of work by the contractor
- 4. Attend contractors induction workshop for all employees prior to commencement of work
- 5. All bidders must attend compulsory Tender site Meeting 10am, Wednesday 6th May, Suva Substation
- 6. Tender closes on Wednesday 20th May 2015 at 1600hrs

SCOPE of WORK – 33kV/6.6kV Suva Substation Transformer T2 oil leak repair

A. Contractors Responsibility

- 1. Identify all oil leaks
- 2. Carry out repair of repair of ALL oil leak(s) with minimum removal of oil from the Transformer
- 3. This includes bolts and nuts, flanges, radiators, tanks, conservator tank
- 4. Tighten and replace where necessary all bolts and nuts relevant to repair of oil leaks with rust
- 5. Carry out all surface preparation works to enable oil leak repairs
- 6. FEA engineers approval for the application of repairs
- 7. Application of oil leak repairs
- 8. Confirm and sign-off ready to refill oil back to the transformer
- 9. Apply 2 coats of paint to FEA suited color to the entire transformer with high temperature resistance suited to Transformers
- 10. Warranty of 2 years
- 11. Procedure to carry out repairs
- 12. Duration of repair
- 13. Client reference list and email address contact of five successful repairs on Transformers greater than 20MVA
- 14. Product used and reference list where this has been applied for the last three years
- 15. Erection of the scaffolding is contractors responsibility
- 16. Supply to Recommended tools to FEA
- 17. Supply of product to carry out repair works
- 18. Train FEA staffs to carry out repair of oil leaks

B. FEAs Responsibility

- i. Isolate and Earth the Transformer, make safe
- ii. Demarcate/Barricade the area for safe works
- iii. Provide Permit to Work to contractor under supervision on time 9am to 4pm on daily basis
- iv. Test for oil leak under oil pressure and confirm OK.
