# Supply of AP75 Base-Coarse in Balevuto Area

#### TENDER DOCUMENT AND SPECIFICATIONS

The Fiji Electricity Authority invites sealed tenders from reputable companies with the relevant experience, for the Supply of AP75 Base-coarse from a source that has a proven history of performance on unsealed roads.

- 1. The Clay Index of the material must be based on NZS 4402, of not greater than 5% Plasticity Index.
- 2. The Clay friction must
  - a. Be free of all organic, vegetable or other deleterious material.
  - b. Pass the 4.75mm sieve
  - c. Be blended so the blended aggregate has a uniform texture with no segregation of fine and coarse material.
- 3. Laboratory 4 day soaked California Bearing Ratio (CBR) of greater than 50, un-surcharged or a crushing resistance of greater than 100kN in accordance with NZS 3111:1980.
- 4. The testing frequency shall be 1 test per 5,000m<sup>2</sup> of maintenance aggregate constructed.

## 2) Standards Applicable for this Tender

The Base-Coarse shall be designed, manufactured and tested in accordance with the requirements for the following Standards.

STANDARD	TITLE
NZS 4402	Methods of testing soils for civil engineering purposes
NZS 3111	Methods of test for water and aggregate for concrete

Note: Bidders shall demonstrate/submit proof of the product's compliance of the aforementioned standards.

## 3) Manufacturer's Qualification

The manufacturer shall have sufficient supply and manufacturing experience of AP75 Base-Coarse for at least ten (10) years for the required work specifications. As proof, the manufacturer shall submit a supply-list indicating the grade of Base-Coarse, quantity supplied, name of client and the year of delivery. Certificates from customers with satisfactory usage may be provided with the supply record. Only those Suppliers shall be considered, for which a minimum 5 years manufacturing and successful service experience is available, without change of basic design of the plant and the material.

#### 4) Experience Evaluation

For evaluation of manufacturer's qualifications, the manufacturer must submit a reference list showing supply experience for supply of Base-Coarse. In addition, if any in-service failure due to the quality of the material has been experienced, the manufacturer should submit the information on the failures including the cause of the failures and the counter consequences taken.

#### 5) Prices and Quantity Required

Prices shall be quoted in Fijian Dollar Currency, inclusive of all taxes, customs, clearance charges, and duties payable in Fiji.

Bidder to Specify Location of Quarry in the above table and distances from yard to FEA Excess Road Stockpile Site as demonstrated in the Site Visit. The specified distance above shall be used for invoicing. No additional cartage kilometres shall be entertained as variation.

## 6) Duration of Production and Delivery

The FEA requires the commencement of delivery of the Base-Coarse by the **1st March**, **2017**. Bidders shall clearly indicate the duration of production and shipping (if applicable). All deliveries shall be completed before **15**<sup>th</sup> **May**, **2017**. Liquidated Damages for delays in supply shall be applicable at the rate of 0.5% per day up to a maximum of 15% of the total contract value.

#### 7) Payment Terms

FEA's standard 30 days payment policy upon delivery of goods and services applies. Bidder's to explicitly note all exceptions and/or reservations to the same if any.

## Hard Copy Submission

**Bidders are required to submit** <u>Two (2)</u> hard copies of the tender bids in sealed envelope which shall be deposited in the tender box located at the Supply Chain Office at the FEA Head Office, 2 Marlow Street, Suva, Fiji.

The bidder shall seal the original hardcopy of the bid comprising of both the technical proposal and the price proposal, in one envelope, and clearly mark the envelope as: "ORIGINAL - PROPOSAL". Bidders shall also provide 1 additional copy of the original bid and mark them as "COPY - PROPOSAL". Each proposal shall be individually sealed within an envelope. The 2 envelopes comprising the Original and Copy shall be sealed within an outer envelope.
