PURPOSE AND DESCRIPTION OF THE TENDER

The Fiji Electricity Authority (FEA) is requesting proposal from Interested Contractors to carry out Footpath Reinstatement Works for Upgrade of Saulei Lane high voltage underground cables in the Lautoka City Area.

TENDER SPECIFICATIONS

Details for Reinstatement Works

The reinstatement works has to be done within the following standards:

- I. The concrete mix has to be of **20MPA** as per FRA Standards
- II. The fill should be firmly laid to even up the surfaces currently left open on site
- III. The reinstatement should also consist of a 665 Mash Wire for reinforcement
- IV. Any other materials required for reinstatement works

Eligibility/Selection Criteria of the Bidding Contractor

The Contractor shall have a sound knowledge of the subject area. Contractor shall also be familiar with the contents of the Authority's "Safety Manual". The Contractor shall take all necessary precautions to prevent any damages to the FEA assets and private properties in the area.

The Bidder shall submit the names/contacts of utilities or projects where they have previously undertaken such work required by this Tender.

1. Contract Price:

The Contractor shall submit the lump sum VIP price in Fijian currency to carry out the following works. The Contractor shall submit his price for the reinstatement of footpath after a site inspection with a FEA representative.

2. Scope of Work

- b) The Contractor shall be fully responsible for the footpath reinstatement works ensuring that it meets FRA Standards.
- c) FEA representative will be carrying out a joint site inspection with the Interested Bidders.
- d) The Contractor shall be responsible to repair any damages to access roads, driveways and other utilities services during the execution of the above work.
- e) It is the Contractors responsibility to ensure they use standard road signs and cones to control traffic and giving priority to Safety of the general public.
- f) FEA shall establish the successful bidder(s) as a preferred supplier and multiple small quantity purchase orders shall be furnished as deemed necessary and required by FEA.
- g) The length, width and depth of the footpath reinstatement works shall be determined during site inspection.
- h) The Contractor shall arrange meetings with the Lautoka City Council, Fiji Roads Authority, respective Stakeholders and Businesses to ensure they are aware of works been carried out by your company and to allow smooth execution of this work.

3. Registration & Other Information

The award will be cancelled if the contractor is unable to provide the above information on time.

The Contractor shall only employ Licensed Machinery Operators and they shall be available on site as and when required by the FEA in 24hours of the request.
